What's New

The Supplemental Staffing Pilot is intended to address two critical barriers reported by Agencies:

» Agencies in need of assistance finding qualified applicants » Agencies in need of additional funding to hire and train staff

Once all staff training requirements are met, the Pilot is approved and supported by IACAA and DCEO. The Pilot addresses key barriers by implementing two approaches:

» Utilizing existing qualified cross-programmatic staff

» Recruiting and hiring of dedicated program staff

For a limited time, a Quality Assurance/Quality Control ($\Omega A/\Omega C$) staff member will serve as a "floating" Energy Assessor and Quality Control Inspection resource for Agencies. These individuals have participated in the Home Efficiency Income Qualified (HEIQ) Initiative and hold certifications through this training.

We are pleased to share exciting news with the network regarding Agency participation in the Supplemental Staffing Pilot. C.E.F.S Economic Opportunity Corporation and Madison County Community Development are two Agencies already participating in the Pilot. We are looking forward to sharing their success stories in the future!
