#### What's New in CAA

The Phase 2 Staffing Pilot is currently underway! Through the Community Action Agency (CAA) partnership with the Illinois Association of Community Action Agencies (IACAA), newly recruited staff were placed with Agencies who demonstrated a need for additional field staff. These Agencies were St. Clair County and Champaign County. The staff are settling into their roles and are engaging in weekly meetings with IACAA.

# Recap and Future of Phase 3 of the Staffing Pilot

Phase 3 will be implemented in 2023. One of its strategic areas of focus is coordination with IACAA and the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) to build a network of supplemental staff resources with a pathway for permanent employment at Agencies in need. The Implementation Team will assess Agency needs for full-time staff and coordinate recruitment efforts with workforce development and employment partners. Phase 3 design will mimic Phase 1 and Phase 2. In an effort to increase access to training, all newly hired staff will begin Illinois Weatherization Training and Certification Program (TCP training) in January of 2023 with completion in May of 2023. As with Phase 2, Phase 3 incorporates partnerships with career centers and community colleges to build a continual supply of staffing resources to Agencies. This initiative will serve as one of the major candidate pipelines to support the Agency Supplemental Staffing Initiative through 2023 and beyond.

By agency Phase III includes C.E.F.S (Christian, Montgomery, Shelby, Moultrie, Fayette, Effingham, Clay), ERBA (Douglas, Edgar, Coles, Cumberland, Clark, Jasper, Crawford, Richland, Lawrence), East Central, (Iroquois, Ford, Vermillion), Sangamon (Sangamon), Two Rivers (Adams, Schuyler, Brown, Pike), Illinois Valley (Calhoun, Greene, Jersey, Macoupin, St. Clair (St. Clair). 7 agencies covering 29 counties.
