

# Community Action Agency Channel

Community Action Agencies (CAAs) administer the Illinois Home Weatherization Assistance Program (IHWAP) to offer low- to moderate-income customers ways to improve health and safety, manage energy usage and reduce energy costs. Ameren Illinois Community Action Agency Liaisons manage the incentives and offerings available to the Agencies participating.



### **Communities Served**

Community Action Agencies partner with the Illinois Association of Community Action Agencies (IACAA), which elevate the health, education and economic standards of low-income residents in Illinois. Statewide there are 35 Community Action Agencies serving all 102 counties in Illinois.

#### Weatherization

The CAA Channel partners with the IHWAP to help low-income residents and households conserve energy to reduce energy costs by making their homes and apartments more energy-efficient. Weatherization retrofits funded through IHWAP include air sealing, insulation and appliance repair or replacement.

Energy conservation as well as health and safety measures provided through home weatherization can ensure community members have access to energy savings and programs. Eligibility depends on household income.



## Career Pathways
